# Make More Room for God

## Greetings Brother Knights and family members,

Happy Lent! I recall the words of Father Jim Rolph, former Chaplain at Powers Catholic High School and current Pastor of Immaculate Heart of Mary Parish, Lansing: "we don't sacrifice for the sake of sacrificing; we should sacrifice in order to make more room for God." In a similar vein, Father Richard Veras writes "there is a temptation to see Lent as a time of self-improvement, during which my focus is on myself. However, my sin shows me that my hope can never be in myself."

With that in mind, I recommend the Parish Lenten Activities article in this Crusader which lists some of the activities available from our four parishes this Lenten season. I would also point you to the Columbia magazine (Jan/Feb issue) article, "Lent, the McGivney Way" by the Supreme Chaplain, Archbishop William Lori, who connects our principles of charity, unity, and fraternity to Lent.

# March as Knights during Lent

March is the month in honor of St. Joseph and the start to Lent. This month we see colors of violet and purple worn by our priests. These colors are a symbol of penance, mortification and a remorseful heart.

Take a moment for self-control through fasting. Don't forget to pray for the new catechumens who will convert to Catholicism this year at Easter Vigil. Remember the people that have gone before us, a visit to the cemetery or mausoleum can help beautify your soul. Almsgiving is the final sacrifice for this season.

The need is high to invite, recruit and enroll new members.

Our next exemplification is April 29th at St. Gerald in Lansing. Please help us recruit to make our goal of 12 for this year. Please ask any 3rd degree members to join and finish their journey in our wonderful assembly. If you have a candidate in mind and are reluctant to ask, let me or any other officer know so we can assist.

We will be hosting our annual US flag retirement in June, please participate and bring worn flags so we can retire them properly. Our golf tournament committee will be starting soon, please help with sponsorships and volunteer at the golf course. More information on both will be coming.

There is talk that the Knights will be helping with evangelization at our parishes. Stay tuned for more information as it comes. We are Catholic men; in some way we are asked to be evangelists. Fear is one of the biggest obstacles preventing people from evangelizing. Fear not, Our Lord was dealt with more harshly than we could ever image. There will be training amongst the councils and I was told it will include the assemblies. The easiest way to evangelize is to make friends and eventually spread the Gospel. We should have an open and cordial relationship with our pastors, our parishes

and then out to the community. Note, the Knights Charter Constitution and Laws implicitly write: "the purposes' of which said corporation is formed, always consistent with Catholic values and doctrine, through common worship, charitable works, meetings and rites of initiation to form it's members in Catholic faith and virtue to unite members in their Catholic Identity and the practice of their Catholic faith." We as Catholic men, have evangelized by hosting: rosaries after masses, Divine Merceries during the week, Into the Breach sessions and even Stations of the Cross with families and fellow parishioners. What ideas do you have to increase our efforts? Bring your ideas to our next meeting on March 2nd.

Last month we recognized 61 Honorary Life Members of Council 695. This month, we are recognizing seventeen members classified as Honorary Members. These seventeen members have provided over 635 years of service to the Knights of Columbus.

The criteria for Honorary Life classification: Members who have attained the actual age of 70 years and who have been members of the Order for 25 consecutive years, and those who have been members of the Order for 50 consecutive years, regardless of age, shall be designated as honorary life members.

The criteria for Honorary classification: Members who have attained the actual age of 65 years and who have been members of the Order for 25 consecutive years shall be designated as **honorary** members.

Thank you for your dedication and service to the Church and the Knights of Columbus.

Note: Honorary Life members are exempt from dues, per capita charges and assessments. Honorary members are exempt from general council charges, but pay a dues amount equal to Supreme Council and State Council levies. Members are free to make donations to support council works, even if no dues are assessed.




